Early Learning Programs

Tuition-based & PFCC subsidies accepted

Tuition-free Elementary

Starting in Early K, our program is free of charge to all participants.

Toddlers

Our youngest students develop big skills in small classes, beginning at Age 2.5

Preschool

Our 3- and 4-year-olds master age-appropriate activities including potty training

Pre K

Students who are 4-5 years old get ready for Kindergarten with concrete tasks in math, science, writing & reading

Early K

Students turning 5 years old before January 1 have the opportunity to assess for an early Kindergarten entrance program aligned with state standards

K-2nd Grade

Our public charter school program guides students through the first three years of elementary school with mastery-based instruction that builds knowledge & social emotional development year-over-year
