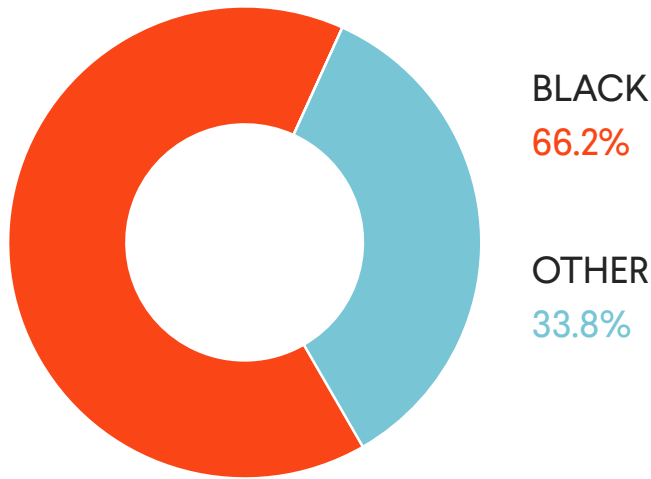

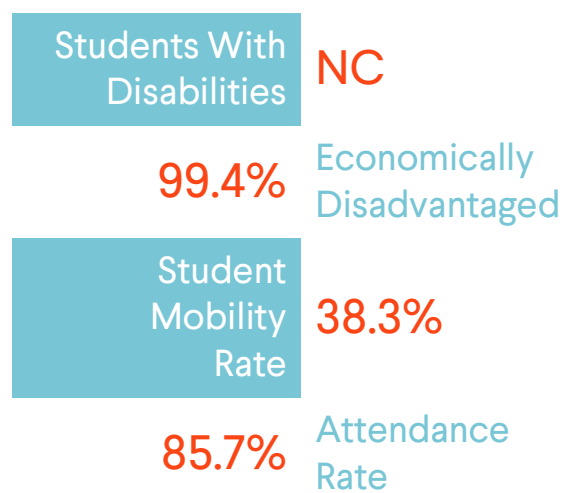

Franklin Learning Academy received **five stars** in **Gap Closing**.

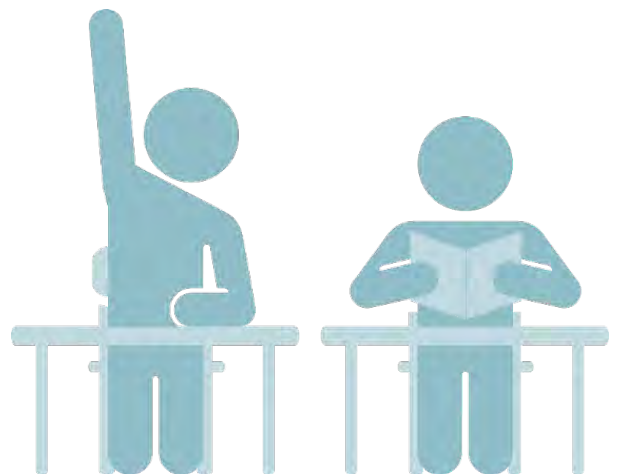
Our Academic Goals

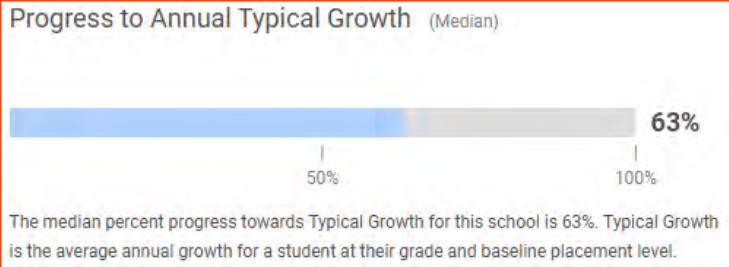

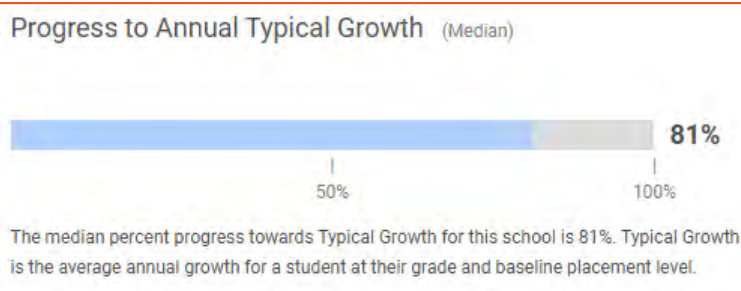
